


## Google Translate Widget Setup

1. Go to <http://translate.google.com/manager/website>
2. Login to Google

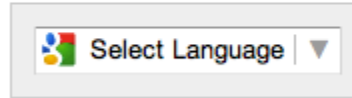
